MTSS: It's just a starting point for transforming student/learning supports

It must be evident to most educators that the focus on MTSS (multi-tiered student support) has increased attention to the fundamental matter of improving how schools address barriers to learning and teaching.

(This is not to say that everyone has taken steps to make improvements to the fragmented and marginalized approach in most schools.)

Where the MTSS framework has been adopted, the problem is that it often is promoted as THE ANSWER rather than as a starting point for developing a unified, comprehensive, and equitable system of learning supports.
